

## **LESSON # 4**

### **Thyatiara the Tolerant/Sardis the Dead**

1-Jer.(17:10) "I the LORD search the heart and examine the mind, to reward a man according to his conduct, according to what his deeds deserve."

(32:19) great are your purposes and mighty are your deeds. Your eyes are open to all the ways of men; you reward everyone according to his conduct and as his deeds deserve.

2-Mt.(16:27) For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what he has done.

3-Eph.(6:8) because you know that the Lord will reward everyone for whatever good he does...

4-Rev.(22:12) "Behold, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to everyone according to what he has done.

5-Gen.(1:26) Then God said, "Let us make man in our image... let them rule over ... all the earth.."

6-Rev.(3:21) To him who overcomes, I will give the right to sit with me on my throne, just as I overcame and sat down with my Father on his throne.

(5:10) You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to serve our God, and they will reign on the earth."

7-2Pe.(1:19) And we have the word of the prophets made more certain, and you will do well to pay attention to it, as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts.

8-Rev.(22:16) "I, Jesus, have sent my angel to give you<sup>o</sup> this testimony for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and the bright Morning Star."

9-Mt.(24:43) But understand this: If the owner of the house had known at what time of night the thief was coming, he would have kept watch and would not have let his house be broken into.

10-1Th. (5:2-5) for you know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night... But you, brothers, are not in darkness so that this day should surprise you like a thief. You are all sons of the light and sons of the day.

11-Ex.(32:32-33) But now, please forgive their sin—but if not, then blot me out of the book you have written."

The LORD replied to Moses, "Whoever has sinned against me I will blot out of my book.

12-Ps.(69:28) May they be blotted out of the book of life and not be listed with the righteous.

13-Lk.(10:20) However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven."

14-Dan.(12:1) "At that time Michael, the great prince who protects your people, will arise. There will be a time of distress such as has not happened from the beginning of nations until then. But at that time your people—everyone whose name is found written in the book—will be delivered.

15-Rev.(13:8) All inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast—all whose names have not been written in the book of life belonging to the Lamb that was slain from the creation of the world.

(17:8) ...The inhabitants of the earth whose names have not been written in the book of life from the creation of the world (NLT-from before the world began) will be astonished when they see the beast, because he once was, now is not, and yet will come.

(20:12) And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. The dead were judged according to what they had done as recorded in the books.

(21:27) Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

16-Mt.(24:12-13) Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold, but he who stands firm to the end will be saved.
