

## LESSON # 6 “THE THRONES”

1-Jer.(4:19)...For I have heard the sound of the **trumpet**; I have heard the battle cry.  
(51:27)...Blow the **trumpet** among the nations! Prepare the nations for battle

2-Joel.(2:1) Blow the **trumpet** in Zion; sound the alarm on my holy hill.  
Let all who live in the land tremble, for **the day of the LORD is coming**. It is close at hand...

3-Zech.(9:14) Then the LORD will appear over them; his arrow will flash like lightning.  
The Sovereign LORD will sound **the trumpet**; he will march...

4-Mt. (24:31) And he will send his angels with **a loud trumpet call**, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.

5-1Cor.(15:52) in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at **the last trumpet**. For the **trumpet** will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.

6-Rev. (21:12-14)... On the gates were written the names of the **twelve tribes** of Israel.... The wall of the city had twelve foundations, and on them were the names of the **twelve apostles** of the Lamb.

7-Mt.(19:28) Jesus said to them, "I tell you the truth, at the renewal of all things, when the Son of Man sits on his glorious throne, you who have followed me will also sit on **twelve thrones**, judging the **twelve tribes** of Israel.

8-Rev.(7:4) Then I heard the number of those who were sealed: 144,000 from all the tribes of Israel... **Judah... Reuben... Gad... Asher... Naphtali.. Manasseh... Simeon... Levi... Issachar... Zebulun... Joseph...Benjamin....**

9-Mt.(10:2-4) These are the names of the twelve apostles: first, Simon (who is called **Peter**) and his brother **Andrew**; **James** son of Zebedee, and his brother **John**; **Philip** and **Bartholomew**; **Thomas** and **Matthew** the tax collector; **James** son of Alphaeus, and **Thaddaeus**; **Simon** the Zealot and **Judas** Iscariot, who betrayed him.

10-2Cor.(5:21) God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him **we might become the righteousness of God**.

11-Jer.(10:12-13) But God made the earth by his power, and he preserves it by his wisdom....When he speaks, there is **thunder** in the heavens....He sends the **lightning** with the rain and releases the wind from his storehouses.

(23:19-20) See, the storm of the LORD will burst out in wrath, a whirlwind swirling down on the heads of the wicked.

The anger of the LORD will not turn back until he fully accomplishes he purposes of his heart.

12Ex.(24:17)..the **glory** of the LORD looked like a consuming **fire**.....

13-Ezk.(1:27-28)... he looked like **fire**; and brilliant light surrounded him. Like the appearance of a rainbow in the clouds..., so was the radiance around him. This was the appearance of the likeness of the **glory** of the LORD.

14-Ro.(11:36) For everything comes from him; everything exists by his power and is intended for **his glory**. To him be **glory** forever.

15-Col.(1:16) For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him.

16-Isa.43:7)... **everyone** who is called by my name, whom I created for my **glory**.

17-Eph1.4-6 For he chose **us** in him before the creation of the world to be holy... in accordance with his pleasure and will... to **the praise of his glorious grace**...v12 for the **praise of his glory**... v14 for the **praise of his glory**.

18-Acts.(12:23) Instantly, an angel of the Lord struck Herod with a sickness, because he accepted the people's worship instead of giving the **glory** to God. So he was consumed with worms and died.

19-Jn. (15:8) My true disciples produce **much fruit**. This brings **great glory** to my Father.

20-Mt.(5:16) In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will **praise (glorify)** your heavenly Father.

21-1Pet.(2:12) Live such good lives among the pagans that, though they accuse you of doing wrong, they may see your good deeds and **glorify** God on the day he visits us.

22-2Thes.(1:10-12) on the day he comes to be **glorified in his holy people** and to be marveled at among all those who have believed.....We pray this so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be **glorified in you**, and **you in him**, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

23-1Cor.(10:31) So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the **glory of God**.

24-2Cor.(3:18) And all of us have had that veil removed so that we can be mirrors that brightly **reflect the glory** of the Lord. And as the Spirit of the Lord works within us, we become more and more like him and **reflect his glory** even more.
