

## LESSON # 7 “THE SCROLL”

1-Dan.(8.26) “The vision...that has been given you is true, but **seal up the vision**, for it concerns the distant **future**.”

(12:4-10) But you, Daniel, close up and **seal** the words of **the scroll** until **the time of the end**.... Many will rush here and there, and **knowledge will increase** ...."How will all this finally end, my lord?" But he said, "Go now, Daniel, for what I have said is for the time of the end. Many will be purified, cleansed, and refined by these trials. But the wicked will continue in their wickedness, and none of them will understand. Only **those who are wise will know what it means**.-NLT

2-2Tim.(3:1-7) But mark this: There will be terrible times **in the last days**. People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud... ungrateful... always learning but **never able to acknowledge the truth**.

3-Isa.29) "Destruction is certain for Ariel, the City of David. Year after year you offer your many sacrifices. Yet I will bring disaster upon you, and there will be much weeping and sorrow. For Jerusalem will become as her name Ariel means—an altar covered with blood. (29:3) I will be your enemy, surrounding Jerusalem .... "But suddenly, your ruthless enemies will be driven away like chaff before the wind. (29:6) In an instant, I, the LORD Almighty, will come against them with thunder and earthquake and great noise, with whirlwind and storm and consuming fire. (29:7) All the nations fighting against Jerusalem will vanish like a dream....your enemies will dream of a victorious conquest over Jerusalem, but all to no avail."... Do you not believe it? Then go ahead and be blind if you must... For the LORD has poured out on you a spirit of deep sleep. He has closed the eyes of your prophets...{NLT} For you this whole vision is nothing but words sealed in a **scroll**. And if you give **the scroll** to someone who can read, and say to him, "Read this, please," he will answer, "I can't; **it is sealed**." ...In that day the deaf will hear the words of the scroll and out of gloom and darkness, the eyes of the blind will see  
Once more the humble will rejoice in the LORD;

4-Zech.(4.1-10) Then the angel ...asked me, "What do you see?"  
I answered, "I see a solid gold lampstand with a bowl at the top and seven lights on it..."Who despises the day of small things? Men will rejoice when they see the **plumb line** in the hand of Zerubbabel."These are **the seven eyes of the LORD**, which range throughout the earth.

5-Isa.(28.17) I will make **justice** the measuring line and **righteousness** the **plumb line**.

6-Ps.(98: 7) Let the sea and **everything in it shout** his praise!  
Let the earth and all living things join in.

7-Ro.(8:22) We know that the **whole creation** has been **groaning** as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time.

8-Ro.(11:36) For everything comes from him; everything exists by his power and is intended for his **glory**.  
**Our Glory:**

9-1Pet (4:13)" you will have the wonderful joy of sharing his glory"  
(5:4)" your reward will be a never-ending share in his glory and honor."(5:10)" God called you to share in his eternal glory by means of Jesus Christ."2Pe.(1:3)" He has called us to receive his own glory"

10-Rom.(2.7) He will give eternal life to those who persist in doing what is good, seeking after the **glory** and **honor** and immortality that God offers.

11-Jn.(17:22-23b) I have given them the **glory** that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one: I in them and you in me.
