

LESSON #12 "The Lion's Roar"

1-Ps.(69:20-24) Reproach has broken my heart, And I am full of heaviness;
I looked for someone to take pity, but there was none; And for comforters, but I found none.

They also gave me **gall** for my food, And for my thirst **they gave me vinegar to drink....**

Pour out Your indignation upon them, And let Your wrathful anger take hold of them.

2-Mt.(27:34) they gave Him **sour wine** mingled with **gall** to drink. But when He had tasted it, He would not drink.

3-Jer.(9:15) therefore thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: "Behold, I will feed them, this people, with **wormwood**, and give them water of **gall to drink**."

4-Lam.(3:19) Remember my affliction and roaming,
The **wormwood** and the **gall**.

5-Amos.(6:12)...you have turned justice into **gall**, And the fruit of righteousness into **wormwood**,

6-Jos.(1:3) "Every place that the sole of your **foot will tread upon** I have given you, as I said to Moses.

7-Gen.(1:14) And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for **signs**, and for seasons, and for days, and years.

8-Dan.(7:13-14) "I was watching in the night visions, And behold, One like the Son of Man, Coming **with the clouds** of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, And they brought Him near before Him. Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him.

His dominion is an everlasting dominion....(12:7) The man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, **lifted his right hand** and his left hand toward heaven, and I heard him **swear** by him who lives forever, saying, "It will be for a **time, times and half a time**."

9-Gen.(22:16) ..."I **swear** by myself, declares the LORD...

Gen.(21:23)...Abraham said, "I **swear** it."

Gen.(47:29) ...Then Joseph **swore** to him.

10-Ps.(63:11b)....all who **swear** by God's name will praise him, while the mouths of liars will be silenced.

11-Isa.(65:16b-17)...he who takes an oath in the land will **swear** by the God of truth.

For the past troubles will be forgotten and hidden from my eyes. "Behold, **I will create a new heavens and a new earth.**

12-Mt.(5:33-37)"Again, you have heard that it was said.... 'Do not break your oath, but keep the oaths you have made to the Lord.' But I tell you, **Do not swear at all:** either by heaven, for it is God's throne; or by the earth, for it is his footstool; or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the Great King. And do not swear by your head, for you cannot make even one hair white or black. Simply let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one.

13-Eph.(1:10) to be put into effect **when the times will have reached their fulfillment**—to bring **all things** in heaven and on earth **together** under one head, even Christ.

14-Eze.(2:9-3:4) Then I looked, and I saw a hand stretched out to me. In it was a scroll, which he unrolled before me. On both sides of it were written words of lament and mourning and woe. And he said to me, "Son of man, eat what is before you, **eat this scroll**; then go and speak to the house of Israel." So I opened my mouth, and he gave me the scroll to eat.(3:3) Then he said to me, "Son of man, eat this scroll I am giving you and fill your stomach with it." So I ate it, and it **tasted as sweet as honey in my mouth.**

He then said to me: "Son of man, go now to the house of Israel and speak my words to them.

15-Hos. (5:14-6:3) For I will be like a **lion** to Ephraim,like a great lion to Judah. I will **tear them to pieces** and go away;**I will carry them off**, with no one to rescue them.

Then I will go back to my place

until they admit their guilt.

And they will seek my face;

in their misery they will earnestly seek me."....

(6:1) Come, and let us return to the LORD;

For He has torn, but He will heal us;

He has stricken, but He will bind us up.

After **two days** He will revive us;

On the third day He will raise us up,

That we may live **in His sight.**

Let us know,

Let us pursue the knowledge of the LORD.

His going forth is **established as the morning;**

He will come to us like the rain,

Like the **latter** and **former** rain to the earth.
