

# LESSON #15 (REV.CH.13) “The BEASTS”

1-Rev.(17:3) Then the angel carried me away in the Spirit into a desert. There I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet **beast** that was covered with **blasphemous names** and had **seven heads and ten horns**.

(17:9-10) ...**The seven heads are seven hills** on which the woman sits. **They are also seven kings**. Five have fallen, one is, the other has not yet come.

(17:12-13) "The **ten horns** you saw are **ten kings** who have **not yet received a kingdom**, but who for one hour will receive authority as kings along with the beast. They have one purpose and will give their power and authority to the beast.

2-Dan.(7:2-7) Daniel said: "In my vision at night I looked, and there before me...Four great beasts, each different from the others, **came up out of the sea**. "The first was like a **lion**...the second beast... like a **bear**...another was like a **leopard**... and there before me was a **fourth beast**—terrifying and frightening and very powerful. It had large **iron** teeth; it crushed and devoured its victims and trampled underfoot whatever was left. It was different from all the former beasts, and it had **ten horns**.

3-Rev.(17:15) Then the angel said to me, "**The waters** you saw, where the prostitute sits, **are peoples, multitudes, nations** and languages.

4-Rev.(21:1-2) Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, **and there was no longer any sea.** I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.

5-2Thes.(2:4) He will oppose and will exalt himself over **everything that is called God or is worshiped**, (including Allah) so that he sets himself up in God's temple, proclaiming himself to be God.

6-Zech.(11:16-17) For I am going to raise up a shepherd over the land who will not care for the lost, or seek the young, or heal the injured, or feed the healthy, but will eat the meat of the choice sheep, tearing off their hoofs. "Woe to the worthless shepherd, who deserts the flock! May the sword strike his arm and his right eye! May **his arm be completely withered, his right eye totally blinded!**

7Dan.(7:21) As I watched, this horn was waging war against the **saints and defeating them,**

(7:25) He will speak against the Most High and **oppress his saints** and try to change the set times and the laws. **The saints will be handed over to him for a time, times and half a time.**

(8:12) Because of rebellion, the host of **the saints** and the daily sacrifice **were given over to it**. It prospered in everything it did, and truth was thrown to the ground.

(8:24) He will become very strong, but **not by his own power**. He will cause astounding devastation and will succeed in whatever he does. **He will destroy** the mighty men and **the holy people**.

8-Jer.(43:11) He will come... **bringing death to those destined for death, captivity to those destined for captivity, and the sword to those destined for the sword.**

9-Acts.(4:27-28) Indeed Herod and Pontius Pilate met together with the Gentiles and the people of Israel in this city to conspire against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed. They did what your power and will **had decided beforehand should happen.**

10-Dan.(11:33-35) "Those who are wise will instruct many, though for a time they will fall by **the sword... or captured or plundered**. When they fall, they will receive a little help... for **it will still come at the appointed time.**

11-Rev.(20:4)...And I saw the souls of those who had been **beheaded because** of their testimony for Jesus and because of the word of God. **They had not worshiped the beast or his image and had not received his mark** on their foreheads or their hands.

12-Jn.(5:43) I have come in my Father's name, and you do not accept me; but if **someone else** comes in his own name, you will accept him.

13-Jn. (10:14) "I am **the good shepherd**; I know my sheep and my sheep know me..

14-Jas.(1:2-4) Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance.(HOOP-OM-ON-AY' ) Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.

15-Rom.(5:3-4) Not only so, but we also rejoice in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance:

(HOOP-OM-ON-AY' ) perseverance, character; and character, hope

16-Mt. (24:24-25) For false Christs and false prophets will appear and perform **great signs and miracles to deceive even the elect**—if that were possible. **See, I have told you ahead of time.**

17-Dan.(3:1) Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of gold, whose height was **sixty** cubits and its width **six** cubits.

18-Rev.(16:13-14) Then I saw three evil spirits that looked like frogs; they came out of the mouth of **the dragon**, out of the mouth of **the beast** and out of the mouth of **the false prophet**. They are spirits of demons performing miraculous

signs, and they go out to the kings of the whole world, to gather them for the battle on the great day of God Almighty.

(19:20) But **the beast** was captured, and with him **the false prophet** who had performed the miraculous signs on his behalf. With these signs he had deluded those who had received the mark of the beast and worshiped his image. **The two of them** were thrown alive into the fiery lake of burning sulfur.

19-Dan. (2:31-44) Nebuchadnezzar's Statue with **toes of iron** and clay

(7& 8) Daniel's Four Beasts: the lion, bear, leopard, & the 4th beast with **iron teeth & 10 horns**)

**HOOP-OM-ON-AY'** - cheerful (or hopeful)  
endurance

**CHARAX** (khar'-ax) to **sharpen** to a point, a **stake**
