

LESSON # 20 (2-1-09)

1-Isa. chapter 60 through 62 is "New Jerusalem" married to her Redeemer. (details of Rev.7-10)

2-Eze. ch. 38 & 39 (details of Rev,17-21)

3-Mt.(25:46) "Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life."

4-Mt.(25:41) "Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. (18:8)... and be thrown into eternal fire.

5-Mt.(13:42) They will throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. (Jesus used this phrase 7 times)

6-Rev.(4:7) The first living creature was like a lion, the second was like an ox, the third had a face like a man, the fourth was like a flying eagle.

7-Hos.(12:10) I have also spoken by the prophets, and I have multiplied visions, and used similitudes, by the ministry of the prophets.

8-Num.(2:3-34) On the east, toward the sunrise, the divisions of the camp of Judah(186,400) are to encamp under their standard.(ensign,flag)
(2:10) On the south will be the divisions of the camp of Reuben(151,450) under their standard.
(2:18) On the west will be the divisions of the camp of Ephraim (108,100)under their standard.
(2:25) On the north will be the divisions of the camp of Dan (157,600), under their standard.
So the Israelites did everything the LORD commanded Moses; that is the way they encamped under their standards...

9-Heb.(8:5) They serve at a sanctuary that is a copy and shadow of what is in heaven. This is why Moses was warned when he was about to build the tabernacle: "See to it that you make everything according to the pattern shown you on the mountain."

10-Isa.(62:5) As a young man marries a maiden...as a bridegroom rejoices over his bride,
so will your God rejoice over you(Jerusalem)

11-Mt.(22:11-13) "But when the king came in to see the guests, he noticed a man there who was not wearing wedding clothes. 'Friend,' he asked, 'how did you get in here without wedding clothes?' The

man was speechless."Then the king told the attendants, 'Tie his hand and foot, and throw him outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'

12-Isa.(64:6) We are all infected and impure with sin. When we proudly display our righteous deeds, we find they are but filthy rags.

13-Jn.(1:1) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

14-Col.(3:4) When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.

15-Eze.(39:17) ...Call out to every kind of bird ...Assemble and come together from all around to the sacrifice I am preparing for you, the great sacrifice on the mountains of Israel.
